Position Summary:

The job of a Youth Ministry Staff Member requires an individual with the ability to navigate multicultural and socially diverse environments. They need to understand

the world of at-risk teens or be willing to learn. They must have an active relationship with Jesus Christ and an ability to share their faith with social sensitivities in various environments. They must demonstrate active spiritual disciplines and embrace YFC's 5 Essentials, Statement of Faith, and Cultural Attributes. They must be able to develop and manage holistic programming both inside and outside schools or facilities. They must be able to recruit and train volunteers and develop and maintain partnerships with like-minded organizations and churches.
