- ✓ Inside the school, tutoring has been a game changer. Attendance is up and one of the moms even got an A in math. The rush of pride, shift in confidence, and motivation to graduate was restored. They are realizing they are capable of much more than they gave themselves credit for.
- On a Friday night, one of the moms had mentioned that she didn't have a stroller for her 1-yearold daughter. The following Monday morning I met a woman who had a nice pink stroller for her. God provides!
