



Merry Christmas Friends and Family,

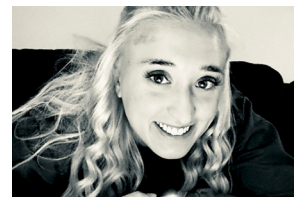
